## FRESH PATH YOUTH PROGRAM ENROLLMENT & ELIGIBITY REQUIREMENTS

Individuals are eligible to participate in the *FRESH PATH YOUTH PROGRAM* if she/he meets the following requirements:

- ✓ At least 14 years of age and not older than 24 of age on the date of enrollment.
- ✓ Currently involved or has been involved with the Juvenile Justice System., which includes:
  - Under supervision of the JJS, either in-of-home placements, on probation, or parole;
  - Under an alternative sentence by JJS;
  - Under a diversion program as an alternative juvenile prosecution by JJS.
- ✓ Has never been convicted as an adult offender under Federal or State Law.
- ✓ Under age 18 at the time convicted of a crime or adjudication.
- ✓ Currently resides in Duval County.
- ✓ Resided in Duval County before confinement in correctional facility.
- ✓ High risk youth 8<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade who are at-risk of dropping out of school becoming involved in the Juvenile Justice System. Participants must exhibit one or more of the following criteria:
  - Poor school attendance:
  - Low grade point average;
  - Low standardized test scores as defined by local school district;
  - Retained in grades 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>;
  - Discipline problems or suspension from school;
  - Special education placement;
  - Low reading and math skills.

## **Enrollment Instructions**

- 1. Complete the Fresh Path Referral Form
- 2. Applicant must show verification he/she has been charged with a crime or adjudicated before their 18th birthday.
  - a. Applicants can acquire verification by obtaining a background check from your local Police Department or Sheriff Substation.
  - b. The background check must accompany referral to be eligible for program.
